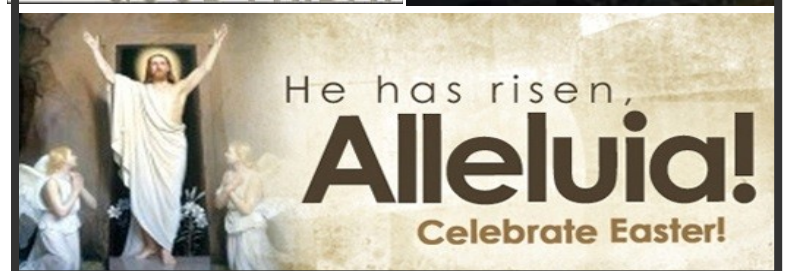
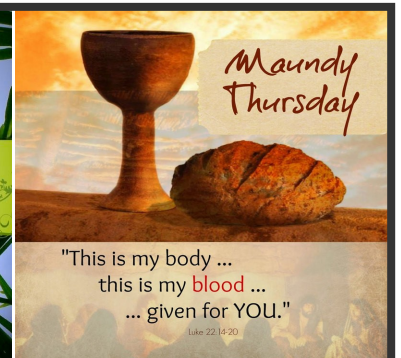

April 7th - Fifth Sunday of Lent	This Gospel tells the story of the woman taken in adultery.
April 14th - Palm Sunday	The Gospel is the reading of the Passion of Our Lord.
April 21st - Easter Sunday	This Gospel recounts Mary Magdalen and the apostles visit to the empty tomb of Christ on Easter.
April 28nd - Divine Mercy Sunday	The Gospel relates the story of doubting Thomas.

Good Friday Collection

Pope Francis has asked our parish to support the Pontifical Good Friday Collection, which supports Christians in the Holy Land. Good Friday Fast & Abstinence

Good Friday is a Day of Abstinence and Fast. No meat can be eaten, this applies to all Catholics age 14 and older. Fasting: Only one full meal is permitted for Catholics ages 18-59. Two smaller meals are permitted but the small meals should not equal a second full meal. Coffee, tea, and water between meals is allowed. Snacks between meals are not allowed.
