**Divine Mercy Sunday is April 19**  
**How to Pray the**  
**Divine Mercy Chaplet**

Our Lord taught Blessed Faustina a prayer for mercy that she was to pray unceasingly: The Chaplet of The Divine Mercy. He told her that, if she prayed in this way, her prayers would have great power for the conversion of sinners, for peace for the dying, and even for controlling nature (Diary, 687, 811, 1731, 1791).

We, too, can pray this chaplet, using ordinary rosary beads of five decades. We begin with the Our Father, the Hail Mary and the Apostles Creed.

**Prayer:**

Then on the large beads we pray:

*Eternal Father, I offer you the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your Dearly Beloved Son, Our Lord, Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.*

On the small beads we pray:

*For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.*

And at the end, we pray three times:

*Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world.*

## An Act of Perfect Contrition

An Act of Perfect Contrition can be done when one lacks access to the Sacrament of Reconciliation or cannot go to confession for any reason.

It requires genuine sorrow for one's sins and the sincere intention to make a regular confession as soon as one is able to do so safely.

It may include an examination of conscience and the recitation of an Act of Contrition. Examples of an Act of Contrition is given below:

### Act of Contrition:

My God, I am sorry for my sins with all my heart. In choosing to do wrong and failing to do good, I have sinned against you whom I should love above all things.

I firmly intend, with your help, to do penance, to sin no more, and to avoid whatever leads me to sin.

Our Savior Jesus Christ suffered and died for us. In his name, my God, have mercy. Amen.
