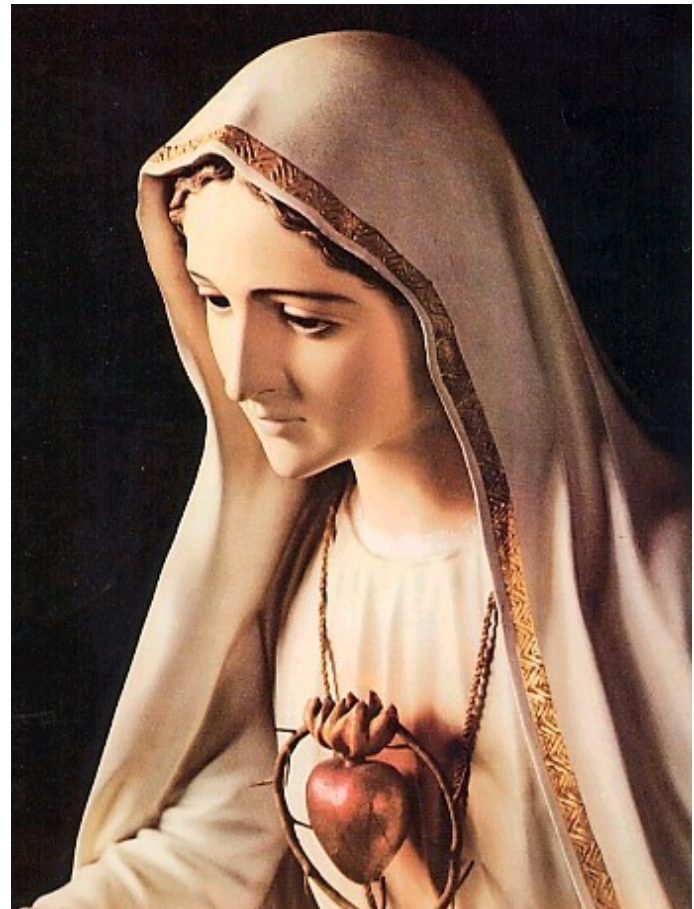

August 5th - 18th Sunday of Ordinary Time	Jesus said, "I am the bread of life; whoever comes to me will never hunger, and whoever believes in me will never thirst."
August 12th - 19th Sunday of Ordinary Time	"I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever; and the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world."
August 19th - 20th Sunday of Ordinary Time	"Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him on the last day."
August 26th - 21st Sunday of Ordinary Time	In this Gospel, Peter tells Jesus, "You have the words of eternal life. We have come to believe and are convinced that you are the Holy One of God."
