<b>December 15th</b> - 3rd Sunday in Advent	The crowds question St. John the Baptist asking him who he is.
<b>December 22nd</b> - 4th Sunday in Advent	The Gospel is about the revelation to St. Joseph of Mary's virginal conception.
<b>December 29th</b> - Holy Family	This Gospel recounts the Holy Family's flight into Egypt
