## Some Things to Know in Advance

1. Only the front door of the church at OLPH, OLF and side door at OLH will be open for Mass in order to minimize the sanitizing required after Mass.
  - Seating is on a first come first serve bases.
  - Doors will open at OLH at 3:00 p.m., OLF 7:15 a.m. and OLPH 9:15 a.m.
2. In accordance of the Archdiocese and Governor's directives, please wear a Mask or face covering.
3. Hand Sanitizer is available at the church doors.
4. Every other Pew is taped off to help provide social distancing. Social distancing in available pews must be maintained. Family members of the same household or who are in constant contact can sit together.
5. Ushers will assist with seating to help ensure social distancing.
6. We will instrumental music only. There will be no choir or congregational singing.
7. At the Sign of Peace, gesture or wave. Please do not shake hands or touch.
8. Please follow the social distancing tape on the main aisles as you go forward to receive Holy Communion in your hand. We will not be distributing by the "cup".
9. Ushers will help with seating and will direct each pew to move to the aisle for Holy Communion.
  - For those who do not wish to receive Communion in the hand, you can make a Spiritual Communion.
  - For OLPH, there will be two stations for Communion one at the front with Father and one in the middle with the Eucharistic Minister.
10. Hymnals and prayer cards have been removed to facilitate sanitizing after services.
11. Please deposit your church offering in the baskets at the main church entrance as you leave .
12. With the requirements from the Archdiocese and Governor, we will need additional help with sanitizing after each service. If you would be willing to help with this or with ushering, please contact Tom Lyons at OLPH, Bobby Feather or Carolyn Wooldridge at OLH or Greg Murphy at OLF, so that we can conform to the requirements for reopening and maximize the safety of everyone.
13. Dismissal—after the final blessing the ushers will direct parishioners in the order for leaving the church to maintain social distancing.
