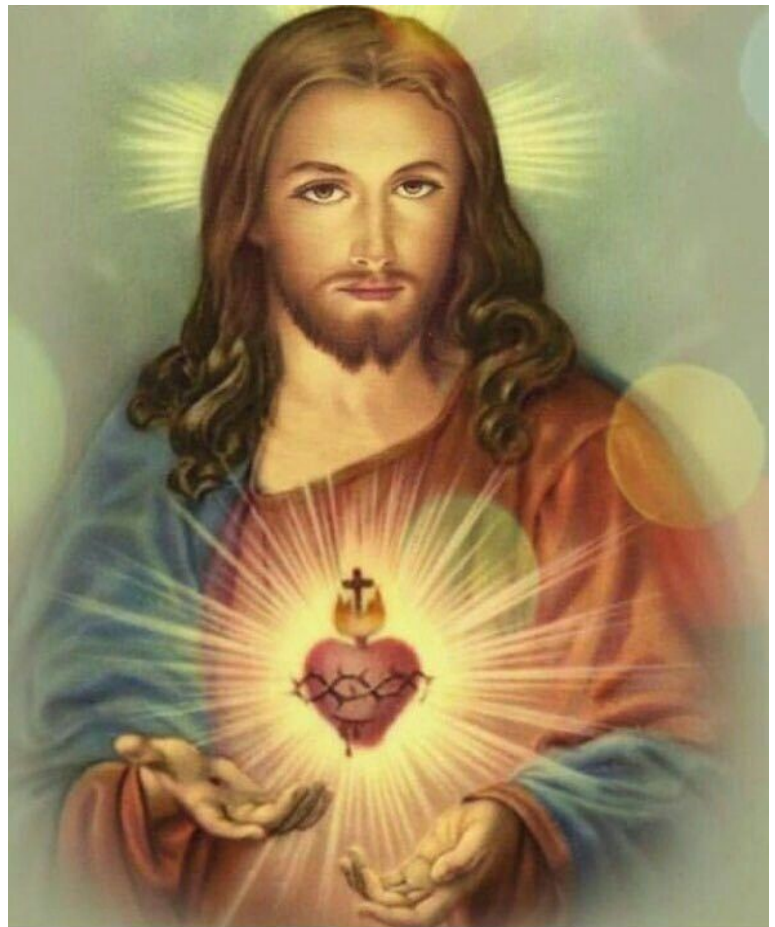

7:30 p.m.

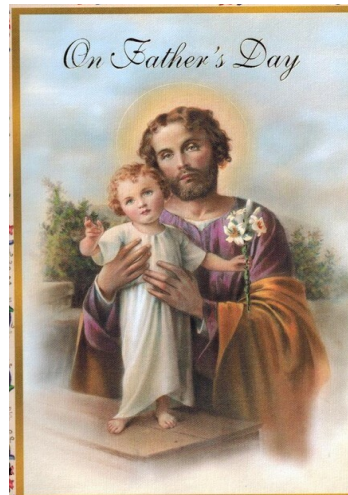
To help with the planning, registration for the 2021-
