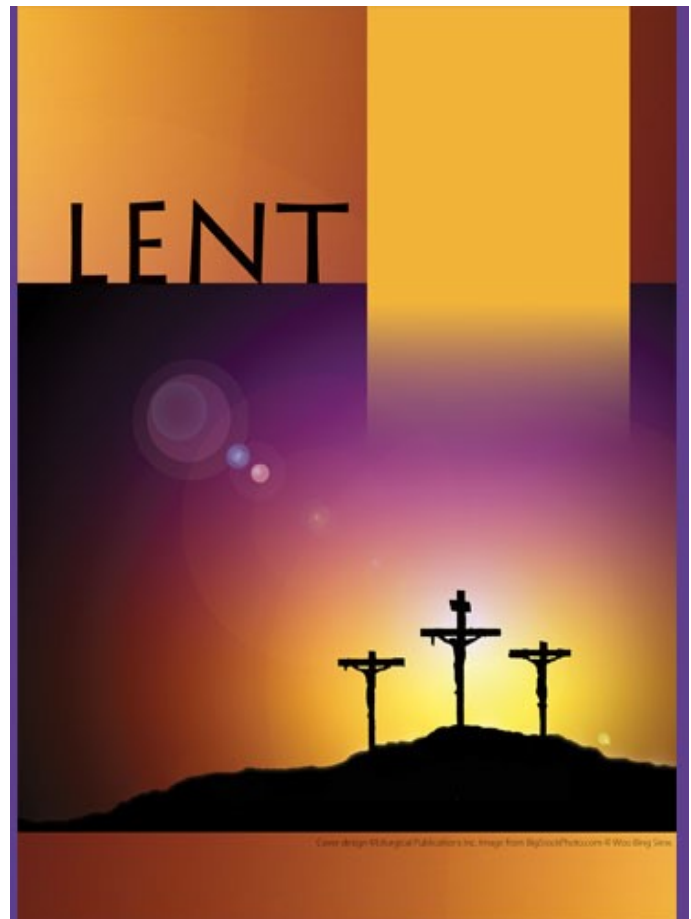

Focus of the Liturgy

The Gospels for the Sundays in March are taken from St. Luke and are from Year C, Cycle 1.

March 3rd - 8th Sunday in Ordinary Time	Jesus says, "A good tree does not bear rotten fruit, nor does a rotten tree bear good fruit."
March 10th - 1st Sunday of Lent	Jesus is led into the desert and tempted by Satan.
March 17th - 2nd Sunday of Lent	This Gospel relates the Transfiguration of Jesus.
March 24th - 3rd Sunday of Lent	Jesus tells the story of the barren fig tree.
March 31st - 4th Sunday of Lent	This Gospel recounts the parable of the Prodigal Son.

Black and Indian Mission Collection

Lenten Fast & Abstinence

Day of Abstinence:

Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent. No meat can be eaten, this applies to all Catholics age 14 and older.

Days of Fast: Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Only one full meal is permitted for Catholics ages 18-59. Two smaller meals are permitted but the small meals should not equal a second full meal. Coffee, tea, and water between meals is allowed. Snacks between meals are not allowed.
