NOVEMBER HIGHLIGHTS

Focus of the Liturgy

The Gospels for the Sundays in November are taken from St. Luke and are from Year C, Cycle 1.

November 3rd - 30th Sunday in Ordinary Time	In this Gospel, Jesus visits the home of Zacchaeus.
November 10th - 31st Sunday in Ordinary Time	This Gospel recounts the Sadducees questioning Jesus about the Resurrection.
November 17th - 32nd Sunday in Ordinary Time	The Gospel is about the destruction of the Temple of Jerusalem and the second coming of Christ.
November 24th - Solemnity of Christ the King	The Gospel recounts the story of the good thief.

Archdiocese for the Military Services USA Collection

The weekend of November 9/10, our parishes will take up a collection for the Archdiocese of for the Military Services (AMS). The AMS is responsible for providing the full range of pastoral ministries to those serving in the United States Armed Services, in every U.S. diocese to every diocese in the U.S. including those stationed at Fort Knox. It provides pastoral care for more than 1.8 million men, women, and children. The Archdiocese for the Military Services receives no funding from the government or the military, has no parishes for a weekly collection, and must rely principally on donations to provide many programs and services. Immaculate Conception

Because December 8, falls on the Second Sunday this year, the Sunday of Advent is celebrated. The celebration of the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception is moved to Monday, December 9, for the benefit of the faithful. The Mass on December 9, at 5:30 p.m. at OLPH will be for the Immaculate Conception, however it is not an obligation. The obligation remains on December 8.

Marriage & Parent Moment

Nov 3: Self-deprecation can be disarming. Tell a silly story on yourself from your youth. Your child may be relieved that you made mistakes too. Teens often appreciate the role reversal. It might even generate an evening of reminiscing.
