<b>October 6th</b> - 27th Sunday in Ordinary Time	Jesus says "We are unprofitable servants; we have done what we were obliged to do."
<b>October 13th</b> - 28th Sunday in Ordinary Time	This Gospel tells the story of the ten lepers Jesus healed.
<b>October 20th</b> - 29th Sunday in Ordinary Time	The Gospel tells the parable of the persistent widow and the unjust judge.
<b>October 27th</b> - 30th Sunday in Ordinary Time	This Gospel relates the story of Jesus and Bartimaeus, the blind man.
