## Flooding in Kerala, India

As has been reported, a terrible flood has occurred in the state of Kerala in India. Hundreds of people have lost their lives, and nearly 2 million people have lost their homes or have suffered severe damage to their homes because of the flood. This flood has severely disrupted the infrastructure and caused the deterioration of health conditions. Two religious orders who are serving so well in parishes of the Archdiocese of Louisville are on the ground in Kerala helping people, and we are inviting donations to assist these religious orders: the Carmelites of Mary Immaculate and the Conventual Franciscans.

We will have a second collection the weekend of September 8/9. Checks should include the notation: 2018 Kerala Floor Relief and can be turned into collection basket, to the parish or mailed directly to the Archdiocese of Louisville, ATTN: Finance Office, P.O. Box 32533, Louisville, KY 40232-2533.
