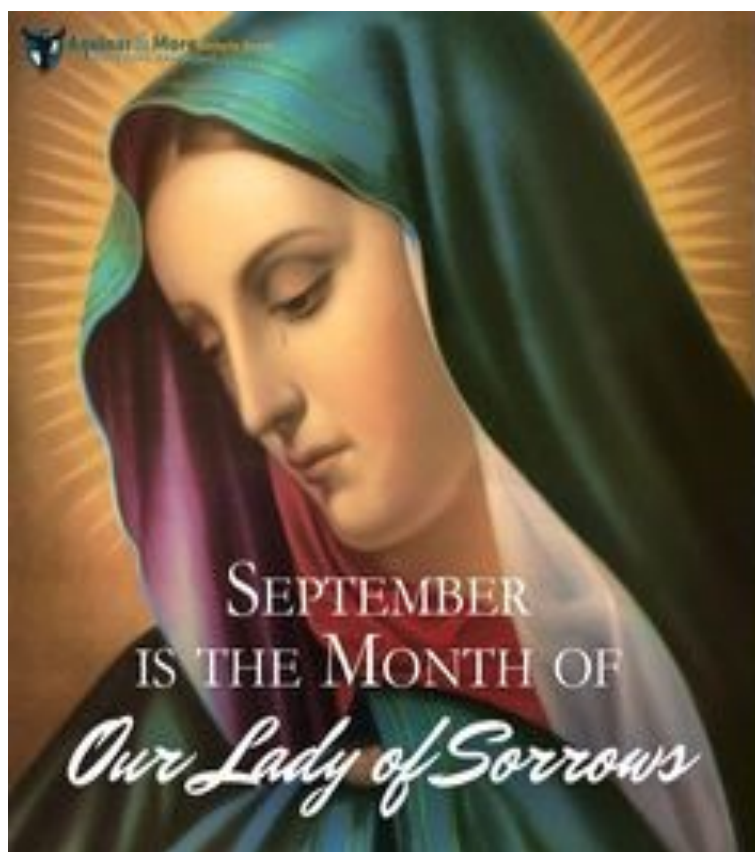

Marriage Moments & Parenting Pointers

Sept 15: The Prodigal Son story (Luke 15:11-32) is about self-indulgence, fraternal jealousy, and forgiveness - all typical family dynamics. No matter the faults in your own family, remember to forgive. It doesn't mean reparation is never needed, but let forgiveness be the foundation.

Procession to Altar

The OLPH Service and Social Service Concerns Committee has planned a Procession to the Altar on Sunday, September 22, to help replenish our cluster Parish Food Pantry. Parishioners are asked to bring your food items with you to Mass and bring them to the altar during the offertory procession. There will be a separate basket for cash donations if you would like to make a monetary donation instead of food. Please be sure that all donated food items are in-date and not expired and are items families can use to put together a simple and easy meal.

- Some of the items the Pantry needs most: Instant Potatoes, Instant Rice and pasta/noodles in envelope packets, spaghetti Sauce, spaghetti, ravioli, Marconi & cheese, canned meats, tuna, chicken, roast beef, spam, canned pinto beans, potatoes, carrots, peas, (we have green beans and corn) peanut butter, crackers and boxes of liquid milk.
- **Thanks to your donates**, 60 families have been helped by our Parishes' Food Pantry January 1, to August 31. That is an average of two families per week that we gave food and kept from going hungry thanks to you.
- **The Parishes' Food Pantry** is available to anyone in need, parish members and those in the community.
- **The St. Nicholas Fund** helps those in need of assistance with their utility bills and rent. Any parish member or persons in the community in need of assistance can contact the parish office for confidential assistance.
